**TEE TIME BOOKINGS:**

Tee Times can be made between 4:30 & 6:30 pm. [May 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> tee times will begin at 4 pm](#)

Day Ladies tee times can be made between 10 & 11 am.

All W.I.G. tee times may be reserved up to 1 week in advance, and must be booked over the phone. [No bookings will be accepted prior to 7:00 a.m.](#) Reservations cannot be made for more than 1 foursome at a time. When booking for more than 1 person, all individual names are required.

**IMPORTANT NOTE: An individual making a reservation on your behalf is NOT responsible for your reservation. If a no show occurs, whatever name appears on the tee sheet will be charged (not the individual who booked it).**

**Cancellations & No Shows:**

**Cancellations for W.I.G. continue to be a concern each season.** Please be aware that your reservation is taking space from someone else in the league that may be looking for an open spot. **As soon as you know you will not be able to make your reservation, please call to cancel immediately.**

Any cancellations outside of the 48 hours W.I.G cancellation window will simply be removed from our booking sheet with no charges.

Cancellations made within the 48 hours cancellation window will be charged the full amount of the green fee, however, a credit for 100% of the charges will be prepared and available for future use.

**NO SHOWS: Any individual that does not show and does not call to cancel at any point (NO SHOW, NO CALL) will be charged the full amount of the league green fee with NO credit issued**

### **DRINK NIGHT and DAY LADIES**

The 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday and Wednesday of each month, **will be free drink night**. We have added the extra days, to encourage you to come back into the Club House to meet the other golfers.

You will receive a free drink /beverage ticket before you tee off at the Starter's Hut.

When you come back in make sure you see a Committee member for upcoming events.

### **KEEPING YOUR SCORE**

Keeping track of your score, birdies, eagles, "hole in one", and putts – they have rewards at the end of the season.

The "Binder" to record your score is located at the Pro Shop; ask for it at the desk.

### **PENNY JAR**

The Penny Jar has been very successful. Thank you all for being so generous. **We collected \$451.88 in 2010.**

How it works: Each evening of play, golfers will deposit 1 penny for each putt taken, into the Penny Jar. If you want to participate you will have to keep track of your putts during play.

Remember to record your putts in the score book (Binder).

### **SOMETHING NEW: IF YOU WISH TO PARTICIPATE. PRIZES TO BE WON!**

After you have put your score into the "Binder"; turn your scorecard into the Pro Shop – this will enable the Pro Shop to determine your handicap and what flight you will belong to. Make sure your full name is on the card. Don't worry about your score, it does not matter if your score is high; it will be fun to participate.

**Keep score as set out in Rules to Speed up Play, if you shoot between 50, 60 or higher.**

### **IF YOU WISH TO PARTICIPATE- Cont'd**

After a few weeks, we will put you into flights where you will compete with golfers with similar handicaps. Example, if you have a 40 handicap you will be in the same flight with golfers with a 40 handicap. That does not mean you have to play with them.

Your flights and standings will be displayed on a board in the Club House. Day Ladies, Tuesday & Wednesday Night Ladies will all be competing against each other.

**Once a month we will reward the top 3 in each flight with cash prizes.**

**RULES TO SPEED UP PLAY**

**Par 3**

You can take 3 strokes to get to the green, if you are not on the green after your 3<sup>rd</sup> stroke, pick up the ball and take it to the front of the green to putt. You are allowed 3 putts. The maximum strokes allowed will be 6 on a Par 3. **Your score will be 6x**

**Par 4**

You can take 5 strokes to get to the green, if you are not on the green after your 5<sup>th</sup> stroke, pick up The ball and take it to the front of the green to putt. You are allowed 3 putts. The maximum strokes allowed will be 8 on a Par 4. **Your score will be 8x**

**Par 5**

You can take 7 strokes to get to the green, if you are not on the green after your 7<sup>th</sup> stroke, pick up the ball and take it to the front of the green to putt. You are allowed 3 putts. The maximum strokes allowed will be 10 on a Par 5. **Your score will be 10x.**
